Dear students,

We are excited to announce the Erasmus+ Support Competition for the academic year 2023/2024. This competition is designed to provide financial support for study exchange (SMS) within the Erasmus+ program. As part of our commitment to inclusivity, students with fewer opportunities, including those with specific socio-economic or personal circumstances, can receive a top-up of 250 € monthly funding.

Who can participate:

- Regular and extraordinary undergraduate or graduate students of ZSEM are eligible to apply.

Duration of Stay:

- Study stays can last at least 2 months and up to 12 months.
- The total support duration, including undergraduate and graduate levels, cannot exceed 12 months.

Financial Support:

- The monthly Erasmus+ financial support for student exchange in Europe during the academic year 2023/2024 is [here](#):
 - 550, 500, or 700 Euros per month, depending on the selected program country for exchange (groups of countries 1-3) or the selected partner countries (regions 1-14).
- Students without travel support based on distance band calculation will receive an additional EUR 50 and up to 4 travel days for green travel return trips. [here](#) you can find a statement for green travel.

Students with Fewer Opportunities:

- We are dedicated to supporting students facing unique challenges. The following categories of students are considered students with fewer opportunities and can additionally have a pop-up of 250€/ month:
 - Students will have low economic status.
 - Students who have refugee, asylum seeker, or migrant status.
 - Students whose personal, physical, mental, or health conditions require additional financial or other support.

Selection Criteria:

- The primary criterion for selection is the overall grade rating.
- Regarding equal academic performance, priority is given to students with fewer opportunities.

Application Process:

- To apply, fill in and sign the:

- Required documentation includes also:
- b) Copy/scan of the ID card for applying within the EU and copy/scan of passport (both sides)
 - c) Copy/scan of the EU insurance card for applying within the EU or copy of a private insurance health insurance policy covering mobility period (must cover at least 30000 €) for applications outside the EU.
 - d) Transcript of the passed exams and assessment of the achieved ECTS credits certified by the Student Service office
 - e) [Filled OIB table](#) (in Excel format)

- f) Confirmation that the student is the owner of that account provided in the OIB table
- For students with disabilities - with all the above-mentioned and a certificate from an authorised institution showing the degree of disability. - Results will be published and sent directly by email to the students after the closing of the nomination process.

Appeal Procedure:

- An appeal to the legal service of ZSEM may be filed against the decision on selecting candidates within 8 days of the announcement of the competition results. The appeal shall be submitted in writing. The Commission shall decide on the appeal.
- All the personal data of the candidates given in the application and in the process that follows the application will be processed to carry out the relevant tender, including the evaluation of submitted applications. The results of the competition are publicly announced to raise the transparency of the procedure itself. The basis for the processing of personal data is the application of the applicant - processing of personal data is necessary for taking the actions preceding the conclusion of the contract and for the possible subsequent conclusions of the contract. The European Commission is the head of personal data processing in the part where processing is carried out for the Erasmus + program.
