

Zagreb School of Economics and Management (ZSEM) – Erasmus+ Staff Teaching Program 2023/24

Are you a ZSEM Undergraduate or Graduate Studies professor eager to broaden your teaching experience abroad? Here's what you need to know about the Erasmus+ Professor Exchange Program:

Eligibility:

This program is open to professors teaching at ZSEM's Undergraduate or Graduate Studies.

1. Duration:

The mobility applications should not exceed a total of 60 days. The Erasmus+ exchange must last a minimum of 2 days within program countries and at least 5 days within partner countries during the academic year 2023/2024, and it must include a minimum of 8 hours of teaching.

2. Financial Support:

Financial support varies and covers mobility and travel expenses. Daily financial support ranges from 112 to 180 Euros, with specific rates for different country groups. Travel expenses are reimbursed based on the distance band calculator. The financial support rates within and outside Europe during the academic year 2023/2024 are [here](#):

3. Special Support:

Participants with disabilities may receive increased financial support, subject to the degree of disability. Certificates of disability must be provided with the application.

4. Criteria for Selection:

Candidates are selected based on their proposed mobility's quality and alignment with ZSEM's international cooperation strategy. The institution's Selection Committee carries out the selection.

5. Application Process:

- e) [Filled OIB table](#) (in Excel format)
- f) A copy of insurance covering at least health insurance

Employees should complete and apply to ZSEM's International Office. Applications and supporting documentation should be sent electronically to amali@zsem.hr.

6. Required documents:

Participants with disabilities should include the disability certificate.

7. Publication of Results:

Results will be published within one month after the application submission on our website.

8. Application Open Until Funds Are Depleted:

Please note that the competition is continuously open until the allocated funds are exhausted. Aspiring participants can submit their applications at any time, and the selection process will continue until the available financial support is fully utilised.

1. **Appeal Process:**

If you disagree with the selection decision, you can file an appeal within 8 days of the announcement of the results. The appeal shall be submitted in writing. The Commission shall decide on the appeal

2. **Data Privacy:**

All the personal data of the candidates given in the application and the process that follows the application will be processed to carry out the relevant tender, including the evaluation of submitted applications. The results of the competition are publicly announced to raise the transparency of the procedure itself. The basis for the processing of personal data is the application of the applicant - processing of personal data is necessary for taking the actions preceding the conclusion of the contract and for the possible subsequent conclusions of the contract. The European Commission is the head of personal data processing in the part where processing is carried out for the Erasmus + program. More information on the processing can be found at
