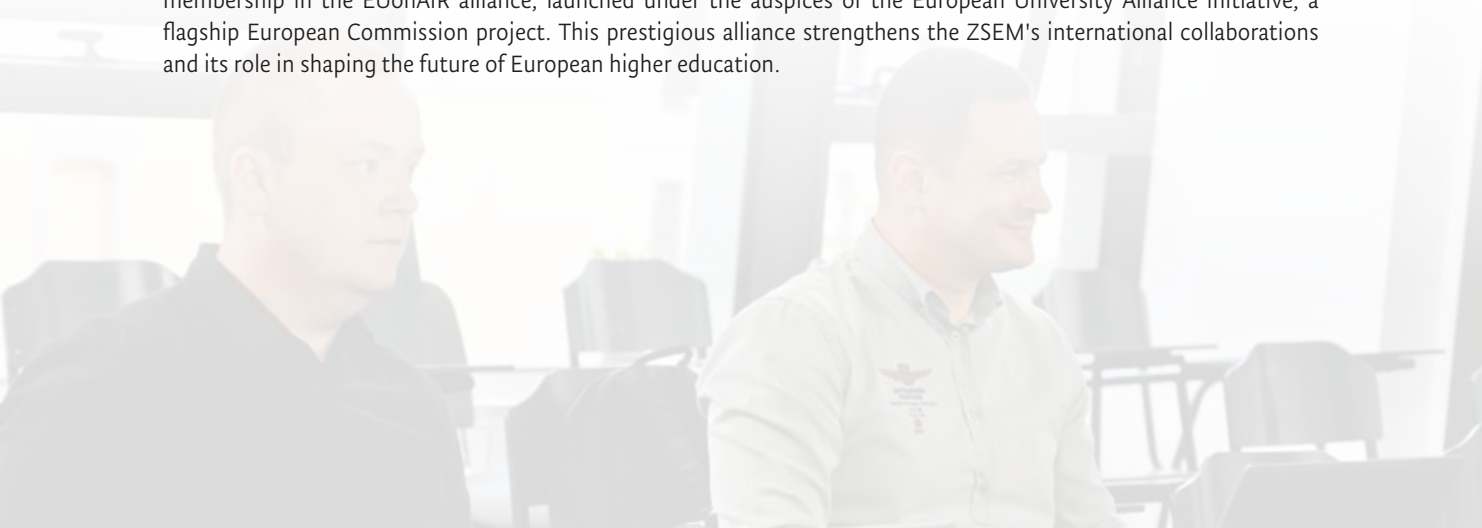

Agency for Science and Higher Education



The Croatian Agency for Science and Higher Education (ASHE) conducted an external evaluation of higher education institutions in Croatia, assessing them across five categories of key quality standards: internal quality assurance and societal role, study programs, teaching processes and student support, teaching and institutional capacities, and research or professional activities.

The Zagreb School of Economics and Management (ZSEM) excelled in this evaluation, achieving a high quality rating in three out of five categories, with the other two rated as satisfactory. This performance positioned the ZSEM as the leading education institution in the field of economics and among the top higher education institutions in Croatia. Additionally, the ZSEM earned the highest "Advanced Level" rating for its quality assurance system, making it the best-rated institution in the country in terms of external independent quality evaluations.

AACSB Accreditation



In 2013, the Zagreb School of Economics and Management became an AACSB-accredited business school. The AACSB accreditation enabled the ZSEM to enter the exclusive top 6% of the most outstanding business schools in the world. The accreditation reinforced the status of the ZSEM as the leading business school in Croatia.

The Zagreb School of Economics and Management has been ranked within the top 200 universities in the QS Global MBA Rankings, strengthening its position as a truly international school recognized worldwide. The rankings position the ZSEM among the top 200 universities in the world and the top 60 in Europe! The rankings were based on the evaluation criteria of employability (40%), entrepreneurship and alumni outcomes (15%), return on investment (20%), thought leadership (15%), and diversity (10%). Using these metrics, the QS Rankings 2020 placed the ZSEM MBA program among the top 120 MBA programs based on employability and the top 130 MBA programs in class and faculty diversity globally.

The program is particularly dynamic as 50% of the program lectures and 50% of the learning is being carried out through group assignments and projects over the e-learning internet platform. 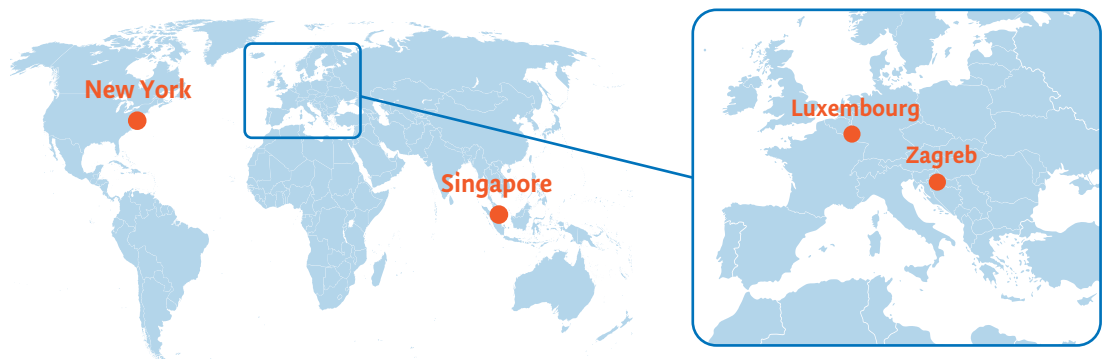

The campus encompasses Castle Point, the highest point in Hoboken, and several other buildings around the city. Founded on the basis of an 1868 bequest from Edwin Augustus Stevens, more than 5,500 undergraduate and graduate students, representing 47 states and 60 countries from Asia, Europe, and Latin America, are enrolled at Stevens. It carries the classification R2: Doctoral Universities – High research activity. The university is home to two national Centers of Excellence as designated by the U.S. Department of Defense and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. As alumni or faculty, two members of the Stevens community have been awarded the Nobel Prize: Frederick Reines (class of 1939) in physics, and Irving Langmuir (Chemistry faculty 1906–1909), in chemistry.

The study trip to New York, which consist of lectures, workshops, and networking with students and business entities, will enrich the student's experience in the Global Executive MBA program.
